Student absences

On occasion, your child may need to be absent from school. Justified reasons for student absences may include:

- being sick, or having an infectious disease
- having an unavoidable medical appointment
- being required to attend a recognised religious holiday
- •exceptional or urgent family circumstance (e.g. attending a funeral)

Following an absence from school it is the parent's responsibility to ensure that within 7 days you provide your child's school with a verbal or written explanation for the absence. However, if the school has not received an explanation from you within 2 days, the school may contact you to discuss the absence.

Starting this week our administration team we will be sending SMS notifications to parents to remind them to provide an explanation for their child's absence. Parents are able to reply via SMS in an easy and convenient manner, saving you time.

They will be joining a number of schools from our Bong Bong Community of Schools and have an action packed week to look forward to. 
