SEMESTER 2 REPORTS

Your child's reports will be adjusted in recognition of the impact of learning from home and at school during Term 3 and 4, 2021. Reflecting the many adjustments required from students, parents and schools these reports will not grade student achievement using the A-E scale. The teacher comment will be personally addressed to your child, describe their progress and achievement in the learning covered and identify what can be done to support their learning growth. Reports will go home in Week 8.

CHECK-IN ASSESSMENT

Year 3-6 students will participate in a reading and numeracy Check-in assessment. The Check-in assessment is a NSW Department of Education online reading and numeracy assessment available to support schools to assess and monitor student learning. The assessments can supplement existing school practices to identify how students are performing and to help teachers tailor their teaching more specifically to student needs. The assessment will be scheduled for our Year 3-6 students during Term 4 Week 5.
