

Our 10th annual Lantern Walk is coming up next term on Friday 24th June and we are inviting our community to help us light the night.

Participating families or groups are allocated a space along the track to enhance with a light installation.

There is no electricity or live flame permitted so the installation needs to be battery or solar powered. We encourage the use of recycled materials. As examples, in previous years we have had crystal mushrooms made with glass bowls and vases, painted 2nd-hand light fittings and butterfly lanterns cut from 2 litre milk bottles.
