To ensure the comfort, safety and enjoyment of all, please assist us with the following:

- Parents/carers are responsible for supervising their children on the night.
- Please ensure your children <u>stay in the lit eating area prior to the start of</u> <u>the walk.</u>
- Your children must stay with you or another adult through-out the walk and move at a walking pace
- Soft lights are part of the ambience of the track so please don't allow children to use torches.
- You are welcome to walk the track more than once, but when you exit please ensure your children do not re-enter without you.
- Ask your children to respect the installations by looking but not touching.

PARENT/TEACHER INTERVIEWS
